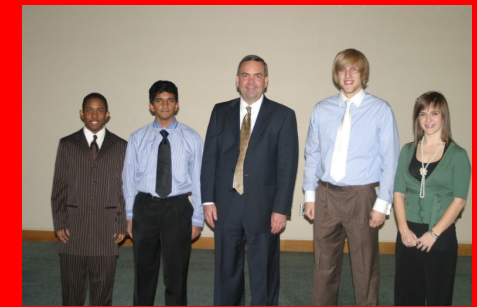

## Committee Goals

- Award a minimum of one \$4,000 scholarship annually for post-secondary construction related educational and trade programs
- Provide mentorship for scholarship applicants
- Develop construction related educational opportunities
- Increase the awareness level of youth in the complexities and opportunities of the construction industry



## Scholarship Activity

The ISA Youth in Construction Committee is hard at work planning for initiatives including awarding an annual scholarship to enter into a construction related post-secondary educational or trade program. In 2009, the committee awarded five scholarship recipients a total of \$7500 worth of scholarship funding, and is now expanding that outreach by specific committee members serving as mentors for each student recipient. Each committee member plans to follow the students through their path in their post-secondary education that will ultimately earn these students employment in the construction industry. Committee members are also working to make contact with area schools that have a construction related program to offer opportunities to students.

## **ISA Construction Career Scholarship**

### ***In memory of Jerry Reynolds***

Jerry Reynolds was President of ISA five times, more than any person in the association's history. In memory of the thousands of hours Jerry gave on behalf of ISA, the association offers a scholarship to aid an individual in their pursuit of a construction career.

### Scholarship Details

#### **Eligibility:**

- Seniors in High School or ISA member employees entering further construction training
- Focus is on students who wish to enter a construction-oriented program
- Student must be a U.S. citizen or documented permanent resident of the U.S.

#### **Criteria After Scholarship Awarded:**

- Student must maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA (based on a 4.0 scale) or equivalent
- Student must enter an accredited post-secondary trade program, 2-year or 4-year college or university
- Student must provide evidence that the degree program they are pursuing indicates focus in an accredited construction-related academic program.

#### **Amount of Scholarship Awarded:**

- Amount of Scholarship to be a maximum of \$4,000, paid out in increments of \$1,000 per year
- Scholarship to have a 5 year expiration date (i.e., if not used within 5 years, funds will revert to ISA for general use or use toward other scholarships)
